NOTIFICATION

It is notified that the following amendments to Ordinance 1 of Chapter IV - Appointment of Examiners and Question Paper Setters - of the Kannur University Ordinances 1999, passed by the Syndicate at its meeting held on 17/11/2020 has been assented to by the Hon'ble Chancellor on 01/06/2021.

These amendments to ordinance shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 01/06/2021.

Amendment to ordinance 1 'Appointment of Examiners and question paper setters' of Chapter IV – Appointment of Examiners and Question Paper Setters- of the Kannur University Ordinances, 1999.

That, a new sub clause (3) is inserted immediately after sub clause (2) under ordinance 1 – 'Appointment of Examiners and question paper setters' of Chapter IV – Appointment of Examiners and Question Paper Setters, as follows.

- (1) Appointment of question paper setters and examiners shall be made by the Controller of Examinations, with the approval of the Vice Chancellor, from a panel approved by the Syndicate on the recommendation of the Boards of Studies and Faculties and/or from the list of teachers prepared as per Ordinance 8 of this Chapter.
- (2) The panels for each examination shall consist of names of not less than 1/5 in excess of the probable numbers or each subject.
- (1) Appointment of question paper setters and examiners shall be made by the Controller of Examinations, with the approval of the Vice Chancellor, from a panel approved by the Syndicate on the recommendation of the Boards of Studies and Faculties and/or from the list of teachers prepared as per Ordinance 8 of this Chapter.
- (2) The panels for each examination shall consist of names of not less than 1/5 in excess of the probable numbers or each subject.
- (3) When the approval of Panel of examiners as required under clause (1) above entail delay in

the conduct of examinations, the Controller of Examinations may, in view of urgency, appoint qualified examiners from the Teachers Index prepared by the University or from the panel submitted by the Board of Studies or from the panel of teachers submitted by the Chairman of Board of Examiners, and such action shall be reported to the Vice Chancellor thereafter.
