ORDER

1. As per the paper read (1) above, the Regulations for M.Tech Degree course were implemented in the University w.e.f 2011 admission onwards and certain modifications were effected to the same vide paper read (2) above.

2. As per the Clause 2.2 "Duration of the Course", in the Regulations of M.Tech Programme implemented from 2011 Admission onwards, "The student shall complete the M.Tech Degree within four academic years from the date of admission"

3. As per the paper read (3) above, the Examination Branch sought clarification as to whether Re-registration can be granted for candidates of 2013 Admission who have not successfully completed the M.Tech Degree programme even within four academic years, as stipulated in the Regulations.

4 The matter of Re-registration of M.Tech Programme was placed before the Board of Studies in Engineering (PG) held on 06.05.2019 and the Board of Studies recommended for granting one more chance to all the M.Tech Students, including that of 2013 admission for appearing for the M.Tech Examinations for all Semesters. Hence, the Board recommended to "conduct at least one more examinations of each semester, after giving wide publicity such that the same is brought to the notice of each and every interested students to enable them to appear for the proposed Examinations",

by bringing notice of all, as the last and final chance to write the Examination. The Board further recommended that further extension and Re-registration should not be given under any circumstances.

5.The Vice-Chancellor, after considering the matter in detail and in exercise of the powers of the Academic Council conferred under Section 11 (1) of Kannur University Act 1996 and all other enabling provisions read together with, implement the Recommendations of the Board of Studies and issued the following orders, subject to reporting to the Academic Council.

6.(i) **The M.Tech Students of all Admissions, including that of 2013 admission are permitted for appearing for the Examinations for all Semesters (Final chance) by relaxing Clause 2.2 of the Regulation, by levying Re-registration Fee of Rs 5,250/ (Rupees Five Thousand Two hundred and fifty Only) as and when the University conducts one each examinations of each semester, after giving wide publicity by bringing the matter to the notice of each and every interested students to enable them to appear for the proposed Examination, as that will be the last and final chance to write the Examination,**

(ii) **Further extension and Re-registration for the M.Tech Programme will not be granted under any circumstance.**
