NOTIFICATION

It is notified that the following amendments to Ordinance 10 (1), (2), (3) and (6) of Chapter IV 'Appointment of Examiners and Question Paper Setters' of the Kannur University Ordinances 1999 passed by the Syndicate at its meeting held on 12/12/2023 has been assented to by the Chancellor on 10/07/2024.

The amendments to Ordinances shall be deemed to have come in to force with effect from 10/07/2024.

Amendments to Ordinance 10 (1), (2), (3) & (6) of Chapter IV- 'Appointment of Examiners and Question Paper Setters' of the Kannur University Ordinances, 1999.

That the existing provision in Ordinance 10 (1), (2), (3) and (6) of Chapter IV - Appointment of Examiners and Question Paper Setters - General condition for appointment of Examiners is amended as follows

General conditions for appointment of Examiners</p> <p>(1) Ordinarily persons with a minimum teaching experience of three years in a College or University are eligible for first appointment as Examiners.</p> <p>Explanation :- Seven years standing at the Bar may be considered as equivalent to three years of teaching experience in law examination.</p>	<p>10. General conditions for appointment of Examiners</p> <p>(1) Ordinarily, the teachers of Affiliated Colleges/University Teaching Departments/Retired teachers from the Affiliated Colleges up to the age of 65 years are eligible for the appointment as Examiners for valuation</p> <p>(a) It shall be the duty of a teacher in the Affiliated College/University Teaching Department to do any work in connection with an examination and valuation conducted by the University, which he/she is required by the competent authority or authority of the University to do</p> <p>(b) Ordinarily, persons with a minimum teaching experience of three years in a College or University are eligible for appointment as Chairman, Board of Examiners</p> <p>Explanation: Seven years standing at the Bar may be considered as equivalent to three years of teaching experience in law examination</p>

<p>(2) Examiners appointed under one Board shall not ordinarily be appointed to any other Board in the same session except for reasons to be recorded.</p> <p>(3) For selecting new Examiners, the first preference shall be given to those who had five years or more of teaching experience and who had not been appointed so far. The second preference shall be given to those who had finished one term of examinership which is ordinarily three years and who had a break of three years or more. The third preference shall be given to those who had examinership for two terms and had breaks of three years or more. The next preference shall be given to those had breaks of two years or less.</p> <p>Provided that the appointment of Chairman, Board of examiners, the rule of preference may be waived for reasons to be recorded.</p> <p>(4) Members of the Syndicate shall not be offered Examinerships.</p> <p>(5) No person above the age of 65 shall be appointed or allowed to continue as an Examiner.</p> <p>(6) No person who has ceased to be a teacher for one year or more shall be appointed or allowed to continue as an Examiner.</p>	<p>(2) Chairman, Board of Examiners appointed under one Board shall not ordinarily be appointed to any other Board in the same session except for reasons to be recorded.</p> <p>(3) For selecting new Chairman, Board of Examiners the first preference shall be given to those who had five years or more of teaching experience and who had not been appointed so far. The second preference shall be given to those who had finished one term of examinership which is ordinarily three years and who had a break of three years or more. The third preference shall be given to those who had examinership for two terms and had breaks of three years or more. The next preference shall be given to those had breaks of two years or less.</p> <p>Provided that the appointment of Chairman, Board of Examiners, the rule of preference may be waived for reasons to be recorded.</p> <p>(4) Members of the Syndicate shall not be offered Examinerships</p> <p>(5) No person above the age of 65 shall be appointed or allowed to continue as an Examiner</p> <p>(6) No person who has ceased to be a teacher for one year or more shall be appointed or allowed to continue as a Chairman, Board of Examiner</p>
