Guidelines for Class Room Instruction, Examination Pattern, Evaluation Rubrics/Evaluation Criteria etc for Hearing Impaired students .

Hearing Impaired students especially prelingually deafened children face significant challenges in educational settings particularly in examination . The UGC guidelines for conducting written examinations for persons with disabilities particularly Hearing Impaired students are a significant step towards inclusive education. Class room instruction and Examination pattern in respect of Hearing Impaired students shall be done as follows

Class Room Instruction

For Hearing impaired students class room Instructions must be disability friendly (based on the severity of deafness) and use more video-assisted/sign languages. Visual resources such as documentaries related to the courses must be included as learning materials. Teaching must be done using elaborated power point presentations

Examination Pattern

In tune with UGC guidelines, objective type method of examination more appropriate for Hearing impaired students. Objective Type Questions must be prepared in simple and concise language. College must provide instruction to the students in advance regarding the examination pattern and way of presentation of answers

Assessment & Evaluation

Assessment and evaluation in case of Hearing impaired students shall be as prescribed in KU-FYUGP Regulation and Curriculum Frame Work w.e.f 2024 except in case of **prelingually deafened students** wherein assessment and evaluation shall be as follows:

The end-semester evaluation(ESE) question papers for theory courses shall be provided by the University. The evaluation for both odd and even semesters will be conducted at the college level

In the evaluation of a 4-credit theory course of 100 marks, 30 marks will be by continuous comprehensive assessment and 70 marks will be by end semester evaluation. Out of the 70 marks 50 marks will be from Examination with Objective Type Questions provided by the University and 20 marks from Viva Voce conducted by the college. Evaluation shall be conducted by the college and total marks obtained out of 100 shall be uploaded.

In the evaluation of a 3-credit theory course of 75 marks, 25 marks will be by continuous comprehensive assessment and 50 marks will be by end semester evaluation. . Out of the 50 marks 40 marks will be from Examination with Objective Type Questions provided by the University and 10 marks from Viva Voce conducted by the college. Evaluation shall be conducted by the college and total marks obtained out of 75 shall be uploaded

Student shall secure a minimum 35% (cumulative of CCA and ESE) for successful completion of the course. No separate pass minimum needed for ESE and CCA.

The college shall submit the list of **prelingually deafened students** of their college along with necessary documents in proof of their disability during the course registration of first semester, for approval by the University



Assessment and Evaluation of prelingually deafened students as detailed above shall be applicable with effect from 2024 admission and students appearing for supplementary examinations shall be evaluated as per the above pattern.
