**ORDER**

1.As per the paper read (1) above, the Government of Kerala have decided to create additional seats in Government Brennen College, Dharmadam, Thalassery, (M.A English & M.A Economics 1 seat each), K.M.M Government Women's College, Kannur(M.A English & M.A Development Economics 1 seat each) and Government College, Mananthavady, Wayanad M.Com 1 seat over and above the sanctioned strength (without any financial commitment to Government) in order to admit the students from Mahe, subject to the condition that in the absence of students from Mahe, no admission shall be done from among the students of Kerala in those additional seats.

2.The Syndicate of this University vide paper read (2) above, considered the matter of admission of students from Mahe to the Government Colleges under this University and resolved to implement the Government Order.

3.Considering the matter in detail, the Vice Chancellor has accorded sanction to implement the above, decision of the Syndicate and to grant permission to create additional seats in 3 Government Colleges under the University, as detailed below, for admitting students from Mahe with effect from 2013 admission onwards without any financial commitment to the Government.

1. Government Brennen College, Thalassery, Kannur.  
M.A English – 1 seat  
M.A Economics – 1 seat
2. Government College, Mananthavady, Wayanad  
M.Com – 1 seat  
M.A Development Economics – 1 seat
3. KMM Government Women's College, Kannur.  
M.A English – 1 seat  
M.A Development Economics – 1 seat

4. In the absence of students from Mahe, no admission shall be done among the students of Kerala in those additional seats.

5. The Regional Administrator, Mahe will take initiative to allot the students from Mahe into the above additional seats on merit basis at the time of admission in the concerned colleges.


