Kannur University - Concession for the wards of Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandit / Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) living in Kashmir valley for admission in Higher Educational institutions from academic year 2020-21- sanctioned- orders issued.

ORDER

1. Kannur University has implemented the following concessions to the Kashmiri Migrants in the matter of their admission in U.G. & P.G. programmes as per the directions of the MHRD, Higher Education department.

(i) Relaxation in cut off percentage up to 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.

(ii) Increase in intake capacity up to 5% course wise.

(iii) Waiving of domicile requirements.

2. As per the paper read (1) above, the MHRD, Department of Higher Education, has decided to allow the following concessions to the wards of Kashmiri Migrants as well as Kashmiri Pandits / Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) who are living in the Kashmir Valley, in the matter of their admission in the educational institutions in other parts of the country from the academic year 2020-21 and onwards till further orders:

(i) Relaxation in cut-off percentage upto 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement.

(ii) Increase in intake capacity upto 5% course-wise.

(iii) Reservation of at least one seat in merit quota in technical / professional institutions.

(iv) Waiving off domicile requirements for Kashmiri Migrants only. Kashmiri Pandits/ Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) living in the Kashmir Valley need domicile certificate.

3. As per the paper read (2) above, the MHRD, clarified that the concessions for the wards of both Kashmiri Migrants and Kashmiri Pandits / Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-Migrants) living in Kashmir Valley for admission in Higher Educational Institutions from Academic year 2020-21 and onwards till further orders are within the existing quota that had been provided to the wards of Kashmiri migrants till the academic year 2019-20.

4. The Vice-Chancellor has accorded sanction for implementation of the above directives of the MHRD, from the academic year 2020-21 onwards.

5. Orders are issued accordingly.
