The Board of Studies in Engineering (PG ) at its meeting held on 26.08.2013, vide paper read(2) above, has approved and recommended the guidelines for recognition/equivalency of PG Programmes of other Universities under the Faculty of Engineering submitted by the above Committee with minor modifications.

The Vice-Chancellor after examining the matter in detail and in exercise of the powers of the Academic Council conferred under Section 11(1) of Kannur University Act 1996 and all other enabling provisions read together with has accorded sanction to implement the guidelines for recognition/equivalency of PG Programmes of other Universities under the Faculty of Engineering, recommended by the BOS in Engineering (PG) subject to report to the Academic Council.

4. Orders are therefore issued implementing the guidelines for recognition/equivalency of PG Programmes of other Universities under the Faculty of Engineering subject to report to the Academic Council.

**Guidelines/Norms to be followed for recognition/equivalency of Engineering (PG) Degrees of other Universities**

1. In the case of equating an Engineering Post Graduate degree (Full Time) from other Universities with that of Kannur University, the following aspects are to be considered by the Board of Studies.
  - a. Eligibility criteria for admission to programme under consideration must be same as that of the eligibility criteria for admission to the programme with which it is equated.
  - b. Duration of the programme under consideration must be same as that of the duration of the programme with which it is equated.
  - c. Minimum percentage of marks/SGPA required for a pass of the programme under consideration must be same as that of the minimum percentage of marks/SGPA required for pass of the programme with which it is equated.
  - d. The programme under consideration for equating must contain at least two-thirds of the syllabus of the programme with which it is equated.
  - e. The programme under consideration should be approved by AICTE.
  
2. In the case of recognizing an Engineering Post Graduate degree (Full Time) from other Universities which is not offered by Kannur University, the following aspects are to be considered.
  - a. Eligibility for admission of the programme under consideration for recognition must be same as that of the eligibility criteria for admission of similar PG programmes offered under that faculty.
  - b. Duration of the programme under consideration for recognition must be same as that of similar PG programmes offered under that faculty.
  - c. Minimum percentage of marks/SGPA required for the pass of the programme under consideration for recognition must be same as that of the minimum percentage of marks/SGPA required for the pass of similar PG programmes offered under that faculty.
  - d. The programme under consideration should be approved by AICTE.
  
3. In the case of equating an Engineering degree (Part Time) from other Universities with that of Kannur University, the following aspects are to be considered by the Board of Studies.
  - a. Eligibility for admission to programme under consideration must be same as that of the eligibility criteria for admission to the programme with which it is equated.
  - b. Duration of the programme under consideration must be same as that of the duration of the programme with which it is equated. A certificate from the university concerned regarding the total number of contact hours, the class timings, the attendance requirements and the pass criteria needs to be produced. Board of Studies need to ensure that the total contact hours during a semester are similar to that of the programme with which it is equated.



- c. Minimum percentage of marks/SGPA required for a pass in the programme under consideration must be same as that of the minimum percentage of marks/SGPA required for pass in the programme with which it is equated.
  - d. The programme under consideration for equating must contain at least two-thirds of the programme with which it is equated.
  - e. The programme under consideration should be approved by AICTE.
4. In the case of recognizing a Engineering degree (Part Time) from other Universities which is not offered by Kannur University the following aspects are to be considered by the Board of Studies.
- e. Eligibility for admission for programme under consideration must be same as that of the eligibility criteria for admission of similar PG programmes offered under that faculty.
  - a. A certificate from the University concerned regarding the total number of contact hours, the attendance requirements and the pass criteria needs to be produced. Board of Studies shall ensure that the total contact hours required for the programme are comparable with that of a similar regular (full time) course or a similar programme offered under that faculty.
  - b. Minimum percentage of marks/SGPA required for a pass of the programme under consideration must be same as that of the minimum percentage of marks/SGPA required for pass of similar PG programmes offered under that faculty.
  - c. The programme under consideration should be approved by AICTE.
5. Engineering Post Graduate degrees (Full Time) offered by the Indian Institute of Technologies (IITs), IISc Bangalore, and National Institute of Technologies (NITs) in India stand approved by Kannur University.
